

# SWAMI SON OF OLE BULL?

## Famous Will Contest at Alfred Grows More Exciting

Overshadowed by psychic chaos of the Raja Yoga cult, with its thought-viands, breathing drills, wish waves, malignant vibrations, incense incantations and orgies, there is a charge

of meddling with assets in the contest over the will of Mrs. Ole Bull of Elliot and Cambridge, at Alfred.

The name of Miss Margaret Noble stands out prominently. She is famil-

iarly alluded to in Yoga circles as Sister Nevidita. An English woman, she champions in writing and lectures the Hindu precepts as standards for life universally. At present she is understood to be in India.
